REACT FORMAT

- 1. Each secondary school will send three of their brightest students from the JS and SS class respectively, making it a total of six students from each school.
- 2. The competition will consist of two rounds. The first round will select the top 10 students from each category (JS and SS), irrespective of their schools.
- 3. The second round will select the top three students from each category.
- 4. The goal of the exercise is to test the cognitive and reasoning abilities of the students.
- 5. There will be three sections in the exercise Verbal Reasoning, Non Verbal Reasoning, and Quantitative Reasoning.
- 6. While this is not a subject competition, it is expected that the students have fluency in English and mathematics.
- 7. Both rounds of the exercise will be administered yearly around March.
- 8. Cash awards and scholastic materials will be provided to the overall top three students of each category. Scholastic materials shall be given to the next top seven of each category.
- 9. Recognition Plaques shall be given to the schools of the top three students of each category.
- 10. All these will be done during our annual empowerment/award giving ceremony.
